

Walker Center Information

Public Transportation from Logan Airport via the Silver Line (see map on last page)

- 1) Pick up the Silver Line bus at the airport terminal.
- 2) Arrive at South Station and follow signs to the subway Red Line. Get on a Red Line train bound for Alewife. (Subway fare is \$2.75. Tickets, called “Charlie Tickets,” can be purchased at kiosks located in the station.)
- 3) Go 2 stops on the Red Line and get off at Park Street Station.
- 4) Follow signs to the Green Line. There are 4 outbound branches of the Green Line, each with its own section on the subway platform. Look for signs for the D train to Riverside.
- 5) Get on a Green Line D train bound for Riverside. (There will be a sign that says “D Riverside” on the front of the train.) Take the train all the way to Riverside Station, which is the last stop on the line.
- 6) Leave the station and walk to the street (Grove Street) and turn **left** onto Grove Street.
- 7) Walk for 0.4 mile to where Grove Street curves sharply to the right. The **first left** immediately after this curve is the entrance to the Walker Center parking lot. (Walker Center is at the corner of Grove and Hancock Streets.) Building entrance is on the left under the portico.

Public Transportation from Logan Airport via the Blue Line (see map on last page)

- 1) At the airport terminal, take the Massport shuttle bus to the Airport subway station on the Blue Line. (The shuttle bus is free.)
- 2) Arrive at Airport Station and get on a Blue Line train inbound to Bowdoin. (Subway fare is \$2.75. Tickets, called “Charlie Tickets,” can be purchased at kiosks located at the station.)
- 3) Go 4 stops on the Blue Line and get off at Government Center Station.
- 4) Follow signs to the Green Line. There are 4 outbound branches of the Green Line, each with its own section on the subway platform. Look for signs for the D train to Riverside.
- 5) Get on a Green Line D train bound for Riverside. (There will be a sign that says “D Riverside” on the front of the train.) Take the train all the way to Riverside Station, which is the last stop on the line.
- 6) Leave the station and walk to the street (Grove Street) and turn **left** onto Grove Street.
- 7) Walk for 0.4 mile to where Grove Street curves sharply to the right. The **first left** immediately after this curve is the entrance to the Walker Center parking lot. (Walker Center is at the corner of Grove and Hancock Streets.) Building entrance is on the left under the portico.

Taxi from Logan Airport (in case the driver needs directions)

- 1) Tell the driver that you are going to Newton. If he asks for an address for the GPS, give him the address for our parking lot, which is **171 Grove Street in Auburndale, zip code 02466**. (Note that Auburndale is a village in the city of Newton.)
- 2) Take I-90 (the Mass Turnpike) west until you reach I-95.
- 3) Take I-95 **south** and go **one-half mile** to first exit, which is **Exit 22**. When the exit ramp splits, stay **right** following the sign for Grove Street. Keep bearing right to merge onto Grove Street. You will then pass the Hotel Indigo and the Riverside T station on the left.
- 4) Continue driving for about 0.4 mile until Grove Street curves sharply to the right. The **first left immediately** after this curve is the entrance to the Walker Center parking lot. (Walker Center is at the corner of Grove and Hancock Streets - look for the red “Walker Center” sign.) Building entrance is on the left side of parking lot, under the portico.

Using a GPS for Directions

The address for the Walker Center parking lot is: **171 Grove Street, Auburndale, MA 02466**

The Walker Center is located in the Village of Auburndale, within the City of Newton. If you are using a GPS for directions, enter Auburndale, rather than Newton. There is another Grove Street in a different part of Newton, **thus specifying Auburndale ensures that the GPS sends you to the correct Grove Street.**

Parking

The Walker Center has **limited parking** available in our lot (entrance on Grove Street), for all guests, including overnight Bed & Breakfast, overnight conference and day visitors. **We respectfully request that all guests consider carpooling and/or using public transportation. We also request that guests use only one parking space per vehicle when using our parking lot.**

Parking on Hancock Street is permitted all day Saturday and Sunday, but Monday through Friday, street parking is limited to two (2) hours between 9am and 5pm. (Please note that from November 15 to April 15, there is an overnight street parking ban in effect for snow removal.)

Checking In

When you arrive at the Walker Center, **please check in at the reception office.**

- If you are in the Grove Street parking lot, you will enter the main building on the ground floor. On the left side of the building, there is a walkway that leads underneath a porch to the entrance. Once inside, take the stairs up one flight to the first floor, and turn left to reach the reception office. (There is also an elevator just past the stairs on the ground floor.)
- If you are parked on Hancock Street, you can enter through the Hancock Street entrance. You will already be on the first floor, and the reception office will be to your left.

Reception office hours are Monday through Saturday from 9am to 9pm, and Sunday from 10am to 7pm. If there is no one in the office, or if you arrive after hours, you can call the Walker Center after hours/emergency cell phone at 617-447-1417 and a member of our staff will come to assist you. **If you do not have a cell phone, there is a public telephone located on the first floor, next to the dining room entrance and opposite the stairway.**

Amenities Provided by the Walker Center

- Sheets, blankets, and towels
- Hand soap and a combination body wash/shampoo
- Air conditioning in each room
- Refrigerator and microwave in Walker House dining room and in Eddy and Yeo House
- Hair dryers upon request
